

Each ornament has gift suggestions to help provide economic opportunities for people in developing countries or to help defray the costs of the new En Gedi Children's Home. The final numbers of the 2016 Global Bazaar are in. It is with **deep gratitude** to God and a **heartfelt thank you** to all the volunteers, vendors, and shoppers that we can report the following:

- Total Sales: \$16,838.49 - that is the most we have sold at the Global Bazaar since we first held it in 2008.
- More than \$7,200 was purchased from fair-trade non-profit vendors and \$9,600 from for-profit vendors (many of whom sell fair trade products) who all donated at least 20% of their proceeds to non-profit agencies.
- Through the sales of these items, all who participated were able to help people around the world in their pursuit of economic and social justice.

last 10 years. Many of them continued with their child until they graduated from 5th grade. The principal tells us she would welcome more lovely 1st CRC people to work with their kids.
