We are always very grateful for your support of our ministry in China with Christian Reformed World Missions. We'd like to keep you, the church council/session, and the church community regularly updated on ways to pray for us. Some items in particular we hope you can remember:

-Thanks for remembering us as Marian's grandfather passed. He died on May 11 after time in the ICU. We are thankful that we could visit him in the ICU before he passed and that we could attend the funeral in Taiwan. Thanks for remembering us as the funeral was very Buddhist. It was a time when we could give reason for the hope that is within us as Christians. Thanks to God that we remained confident in being present at the funeral and supporting the family, while not compromising any of our beliefs. Overall, it was good to be with the family.

-Thanks for God's provision in attending the Hong Kong conference that I mentioned in our newsletter. There were about 3,500 people who attended the event. Most were from Mainland China. The title of the conference was "Reformation 500 and the Gospel." Special thanks that the authorities did not cause any disruptions to the event. Also, thanks that connections were made with friends and colleagues. This was a helpful event to build partnerships.

-Petition for strength in June: We have two colleagues from the States coming for a visit in mid-June. I'll travel with them to three cities. Prayer for security, for smooth communication in Chinese, that conversations would bear fruit, and for safe travel. Prayer for Marian and me because we will be away from each other during that time.
